




## **Traffic Management at Moy**

To ensure that minimal disruption is caused to road users and attendees we have set out some traffic management measures which are outlined below:

- Thee-way temporary traffic lights will be initiated on a part-time basis on the A9 at the B9154 Moy south junction on 8th and 9th August. Road users will be directed to these temporary traffic lights when exiting the fair.
- This will only be activated at peak flow times to safety manage those leaving the fair and joining the A9.
- Road users are advised to approach with care. These measures will only be in place during the day between the hours of 8am till 6pm. The image outlines the location of these part time traffic lights.
- Road users are advised when exiting Moy Country Fair, to follow diversion signs that will direct them to the B9154 Moy South junction where they may potentially meet the part-time temporary traffic lights.



- There will be no diversion to road users who are entering Moy Country Fair.
- Residents of the surrounding areas including Daviot will still have access to B9154 northbound.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank road users for their patience while these temporary traffic lights are in place and hope all attendees enjoy Moy Country Fair 2025.
